Extensive experience and expertise in the financial sector, Islamic finance/takaful or capital market environment will be an advantage. This is a mid-management level role in a project driven environment.

Responsibilities

Candidates should be able to:

- Read, Research, Interpret and Develop technically sound accounting standards, from inception to completion, for issuance as Malaysian accounting and financial reporting standards in order to meet international and national reporting standards.
- Plan, develop and manage relationships with stakeholders.
- Develop working relationships with stakeholders, key external technical professional contacts – local, regional and world-wide to represent the interests of MASB.

- Coordinate the working groups and special projects.
- Manage, coach, develop and build technical executives within MASB

Requirements

- Passion and commitment for research, analysis and information seeking, with appreciation and awareness of the commercial, regulatory and legislative aspects in the application of accounting standards.
